* Parents are advised to be at the designated stop **five minutes in advance** for boarding.



School Bus Rules and Regulations

- 1- Students must listen to the driver and bus conductors (two lunch supervisors) by following their instructions. The driver and bus conductors have the authority of a classroom teacher.
- 2- All students should be seated in the bus and fasten their seat belts.
- 3- All parents should bring and pick up their child/ children on time according to the bus school timetable. **The bus will leave as per the time allocated for each destination and no late comers will be entertained.**
- 4- It is parent's responsibility to arrive at the allocated bus stop 10 minutes before the bus scheduled arrival time.
- 5- If crossing the street to board the bus and after exiting the bus, it is the parent's/after school care's responsibility to take care of their child/children.
- 6- Students must remain properly seated at all times.
- 7- It is parent's/student's responsibility to wait until the bus comes to a complete stop and the doors are opened before approaching the bus.



8- Students are to keep all body parts inside the bus. (Hands, arms, head, hair, etc.)

9- Students are to keep their hands and feet to themselves. (No fighting; horseplay)

10- Students are not to eat or drink while on the bus.

11- Students are not to throw objects of any kind either inside the bus, out of the bus, or around the bus.

12- Students should help keep the bus clean, sanitary, and orderly. They must not damage or abuse bus seats or equipment.

13- Students are not to use abusive language or profanity, obscene or rude gestures, or spit while on the bus.

14- Students may NOT bring large musical instruments, any animals, balloons, glass containers or objects, or large school projects onto the bus.

15- Students are not to leave the bus without the driver's and bus conductors' permission, except on arrival at their assigned bus stop or at school.



16- Students must remain out of the driver's seat and refrain from unnecessary conversation with the driver while the bus is in motion.

17- Students are not to touch the emergency equipment on the bus (emergency doors, windows, roof hatches, body fluid/first aid kits, 2-way radios, etc.) except as directed by the driver or during an actual emergency.

18- Students are to conduct themselves on the bus in such a way that will not distract the driver and bus conductors. Distracting the driver puts everyone on the bus at risk.

19- The bus windows should not be opened without permission from the driver.

20- Outside of ordinary conversation in a normal tone, classroom conduct is to be observed when on the bus. The driver has authority to prohibit any conversation.
